



Elevate the iLevel all the way up.



• Remove the (8) 4mm seat pan screws.



 Strap the front of the seat frame down to the tie down brackets.



• Locate the front of the clevis pin on the tilt actuator.



Remove the split ring and washer from the clevis pin using a snap ring pliers or two flat head screw drivers.





Tap the clevis pin out with a long screw driver & hammer.



Let the front of the tilt actuator drop down.




Remove the seat back shroud (4) phillips head screws.







Unplug the tilt actuator from the seating module.



Remove the (4) 3mm allen screws that hold the rear wire cover on.






- Cut the zip tie that holds the tilt actuator harness and the zip tie that's on the under side of the seat frame that is also holding the tilt actuator harness in place.
- Then run the tilt actuator harness through the rear wire cover and then pop it off the first link in the wire track.

- Remove the rear tilt actuator bolt using a 5mm L shaped allen.
- Once you get the threads past the left eyelet (left side as seated in the chair) you can then tap the bolt out with a screw driver and hammer.
- Lift up on the front of the tilt actuator while pulling down on the rear of it to remove out the back of the seat frame.





Slide tilt actuator back first over curved support bracket with motor facing right side of unit as seated in the chair.






Install the rear tilt actuator bolt first.






Reinstall zip ties at the locations were we had taken off.



Run the tilt actuator harness up through the rear wire cover and install the (4) 3mm allen screws to hold the cover on.

• Run the tilt actuator harness up to the seating module and plug it into port A1.

Reinstall the seat back shroud
(4) phillips head screws.



- Attach the front of the tilt actuator to the seat frame with available clevis pin.
- Note that you might have to power on the chair and run the tilt actuator up/down to line up the clevis pin with the seat frame eyelet.





Install front clevis pin washer and spilt ring.





Reinstall the seat pan.
