



A Mother's Invention...

Debby Elnantan invented the Upsee as a walking aid for her two-year-old son Rotem, who has cerebral palsy. She later brought her invention to Firefly for help with design and development, and now the Upsee is helping children around the world.

The Upsee is made up of three parts:
