In addition he has a severe right knee problem which causes the joint to 'give way' unexpectedly resulting in falls and injury. Getting in and out of a chair is one action that has been causing Ray to stumble and fall – hence his use of the pioneering SitnStand.

Exclusively launched in the UK, SitnStand is a portable device that provides safer sitting and standing for individuals with restricted mobility. It is a simple yet highly effective solution that incorporates air driven inflation and advanced technology – delivering an elevating level seat pad suitable for all types of chair, in any situation or location. This ensures users, such as Ray, can sit down and stand up more easily at home and when outdoors.

There is no other lightweight solution available on the market that can transported and used outside of the home in locations such as restaurants, hotels and caravans. At home the SitnStand allows individuals to use sofas and dining chairs without the worry of losing independence. It eliminates the need for assistance from carers or relatives who benefit from reduced risk of back injury. Endorsed by the highly respected Occupational Therapist, Kate Sheehan, the SitnStand represents a 'step-change' in personal mobility.

It's light to carry around when I am using my sticks and easy to operate, I can even use it watch and feed my fish. My mum used to have an electric riser chair however she got confused with all the buttons, SitnStand only has two - up and down. As I never know when my knee might fail resulting in a possible fall, I need extra reassurance getting out of a chair, SitnStand gives me this."

"I'm not going out on my own currently however I can definitely see how the product would give independence. We just returned from a caravanning holiday before I got the SitnStand which was a shame, it would have been a massive help then. I'll definitely be taking it away with me next year when we holiday in a caravan."

If not visiting his daughter or at the hospital, Ray spends most days at home alone as his wife works at a local Secondary School. This is a concern for the whole family as Ray can fall at any point and hence remains downstairs throughout the day. Nevertheless the SitnStand means Ray can sit down and stand up on his own which is a major





benefit as his daughter Clare explains: "As soon as I saw the SitnStand I immediately knew it would assist my Dad. He has been trialling the SitnStand in his home and found it to be very helpful, especially on those days when his back and knee are particularly sore. It is also reassuring for Mum when we aren't with him, as she knows he is able to get up from a seat without injuring himself or falling over."
